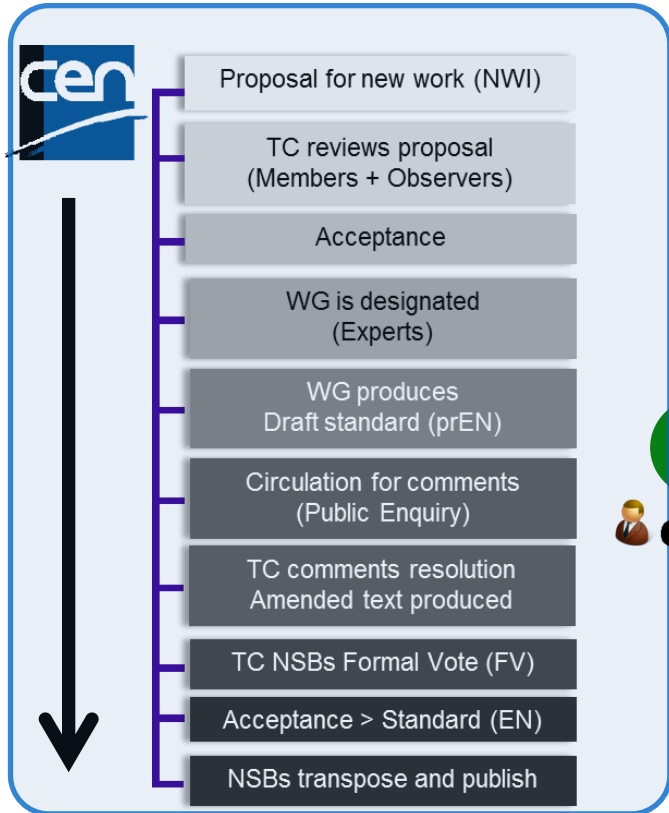

ETUI analyses the information collected in the WG meetings and select a number of topics. These are then shared with TU contacts: national active members, EU federations, the ETUI network. Whenever possible, a feedback project can be started. The machinery topics are also brought into the ErgoMach platform in order to make progress by means of cooperative work between manufacturers and ergonomers.

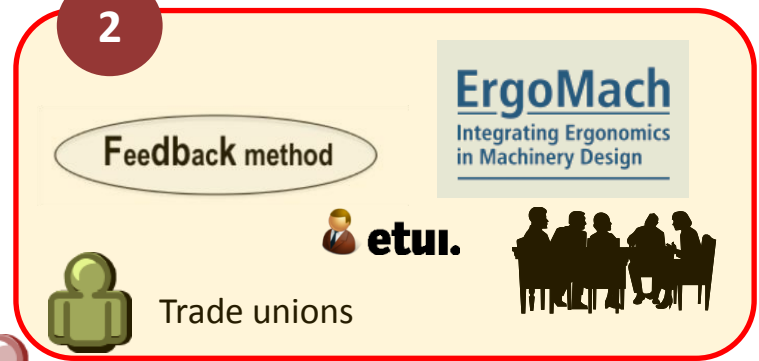

ETUI injects OHS recommendations into Standards in three ways: 1) Direct participation in CEN TC 114 (safety of machinery) TC 122 (Ergonomics) and TC 150 (industrial trucks) as CEN Partner 2) Promotion of TU pressure at national level through « mirror » TCs 3) Direct participation in the « governance » of the CEN system in order to improve procedures, rules, transparency.



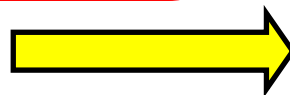
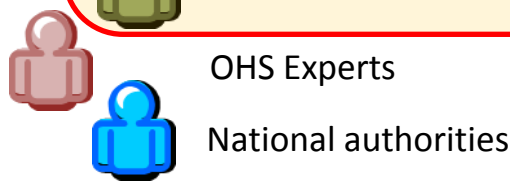
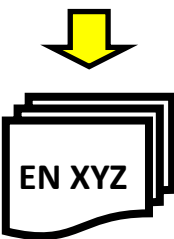
